

EFC-400 Release 2021 – up to 10 Program Instances

Overview of the new features:

Storage of calculations with limit value guideline as B%- and E%-data
Triangulation with selectable resolution from 2000x2000 to 8000x8000 points
Automated batch processing without interruption through warning dialogs
Adding the maximum calculation result value to the coordinate list
New program for subtraction of calculation datasets
Improved presentation of maximum values in X- and Y-window
Simultaneous and efficient working with up to 10 instances
New Models in Libraries for Ships and Trains
3D-Hardware – Acceleration can be turned off now

General Improvements:

- As in previous releases, the hardlock drivers are up to date.
- The Audible QSI export has now been adjusted to exclude any surcharges from export for all procedures F2 to F12. Setting surcharges on the QSI model is the sole responsibility of the sound expert's user.
- During QSI export the configuration is now logged under the name 'Noise2QsiConfig.log' and saved to the same path as the QSI data.
- When working with EFC-400, it is possible to open up to ten instances on one computer (ten is the preset maximum). This can be an advantage when multiple calculations are to be carried out simultaneously. When instances are closed in order to open new ones, it was up to now necessary to do this in chronologically reversed order. This procedure is not necessary anymore since each instance memorizes automatically the right order of directories and sequences.

Virtual Reality Interface:

- The legend for presentation of calculation results in the 3D-Virtual-Reality-window is now displayed sharper.
- The 3D-hardware acceleration can be deactivated in 'Advanced Settings | System'.

Cartographical Data:

• When loading dxf background maps 'frozen layers' are no longer displayed.

Extension of Libraries:

• A new example of a container ship with an antenna system on the ship's bridge is included in the high frequency version. This model can also be found in the antenna library with the name 'Ship'.




Fig.: new example of a container ship with antenna system





Fig.: new example of an auto-transformator-station for train supply


New Calculation Functions:

- If the program for automated batch processing (batch-file) was called from the command line, it was possible to interrupt the continuous processing by warning dialogs such as 'The calculation area will be adapted to the ground profile!' Now all warning dialogs are suppressed when executing from the command line, because it is assumed that experienced users check the geometry in detail before.
- B- and E-field calculations executed with a selected limit value guideline can now also be saved as B% and E% data. When reloading, the selected limit value guideline is automatically restored.
- When triangulating xyz ground data, the user can now set the raster resolution via a local context menu. The range of values lies between a resolution of 2000 x 2000 points and a maximum of 8000 x 8000 points.



The error of the triangulation can be read by the user from the 'error.log' file or can be written to the coordinate list as
maximum DTM deviation during triangulation by activating the 'point with maximum dz to coordinate list' option.


Furthermore, these point deviations can be displayed as sphere markings in 3D to control if they are relevant for the route of the transmission line.



• For additional control, tower and building positions over the terrain are logged in the file 'Object2Ground.log' when loading a raster data DTM, which allows to check how much the z-object height differs from the z-coordinate of the terrain.



A new program called 'Diff_Converter' can be found in the directory 'EFC-400/WhatsNew/Tools'. It can be used to subtract
or add different calculation datasets. This feature makes it possible to calculate the difference between target and actual
states, for example.



Improved User Interface:

• In the coordinate list there is now a local context menu which can be opened with the right mouse button and contains two new commands. First: 'add maximum value to list' adds the maximum value of a calculation to the coordinate list as a point, so it is no longer necessary to determine it manually with the cursor in the calculation window. Second: the command 'add ground height to z-coordinate' adds the height of the ground to relative z-coordinates, if the z-coordinates are not already absolute heights.



• When displaying big calculation datasets as a set of curves (in green) in the X- or Y-plot, only a small, statistical selection of curves is selected for faster image generation. Until now, data was discarded in this procedure and that is why it was possible that the actual maximum value was not displayed. The procedure was modified so that the maximum value is now searched for and displayed in every interval section.




Fig.: old data presentation (left) compared to new one with improved resolution of the maximum values (right)

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
